

AP EUROPEAN HISTORY COLLEGE BOARD STANDARDS

CR1 — The course emphasizes relevant factual knowledge about European history from 1450 to the present to highlight intellectual, cultural, political, diplomatic, social, and economic developments.

CR2 — The course includes teaches students to analyze evidence and interpretations presented in historical scholarship.

CR3 — The course includes extensive instruction in analysis and interpretation of a wide variety of primary sources, such as documentary material, maps, statistical tables, works of art, and pictorial and graphic materials.

CR4 — Evidence of curricular Requirement: The course provides students with frequent practice in writing analytical and interpretive essays such as document-based questions (DBQ) and thematic essays (see the Course Description for more information).
